

Future Accommodation Model (FAM)

FAM pilot creates a wider choice and flexibility, over how and with whom SP choose to live. Service Families Accommodation (SFA) and Single Living Accommodation (SLA) will remain available. There is also support available to SP who want to live within the Private Rental Sector (PRS) or own a home (MOH).

To be eligible for accommodation under FAM you should meet the following criteria:

- A permanent posting to a FAM approved UIN
- Have completed formal training
- Have at least 6 months remaining on your assignment order
- Have one or more years' service

Submit an application via JPA by selecting self-service and choosing FAM Accommodation Preference Form(APF).

Under the FAM Pilot, SP in Long Term Relationships (Established) are entitled to SFA & PRS the same as married couples and SP in civil partnerships. If you have FAM eligible children who stay with you for over 80 nights per year, you can now also apply for SFA & PRS.

Your FAM Accommodation Options

- The Maintain your Own Home (MOH) option provides financial support to Service Personnel (SP) who maintain and live within a property, that is either owned by the SP near or away from their unit or rented away from their Unit.
- SP choosing the Private Rental Sector (PRS) are provided financial support towards renting a property allowing them the choice over where and whom they live with.
- Service Families Accommodation (SFA) remains an available option to SP previously eligible with widened entitlement to SFA to SP who are in a Long-Term Relationship that is Established or SP that have children stay with them for more than 80 nights per year.
- Single Living Accommodation (SLA) remains available to SP.

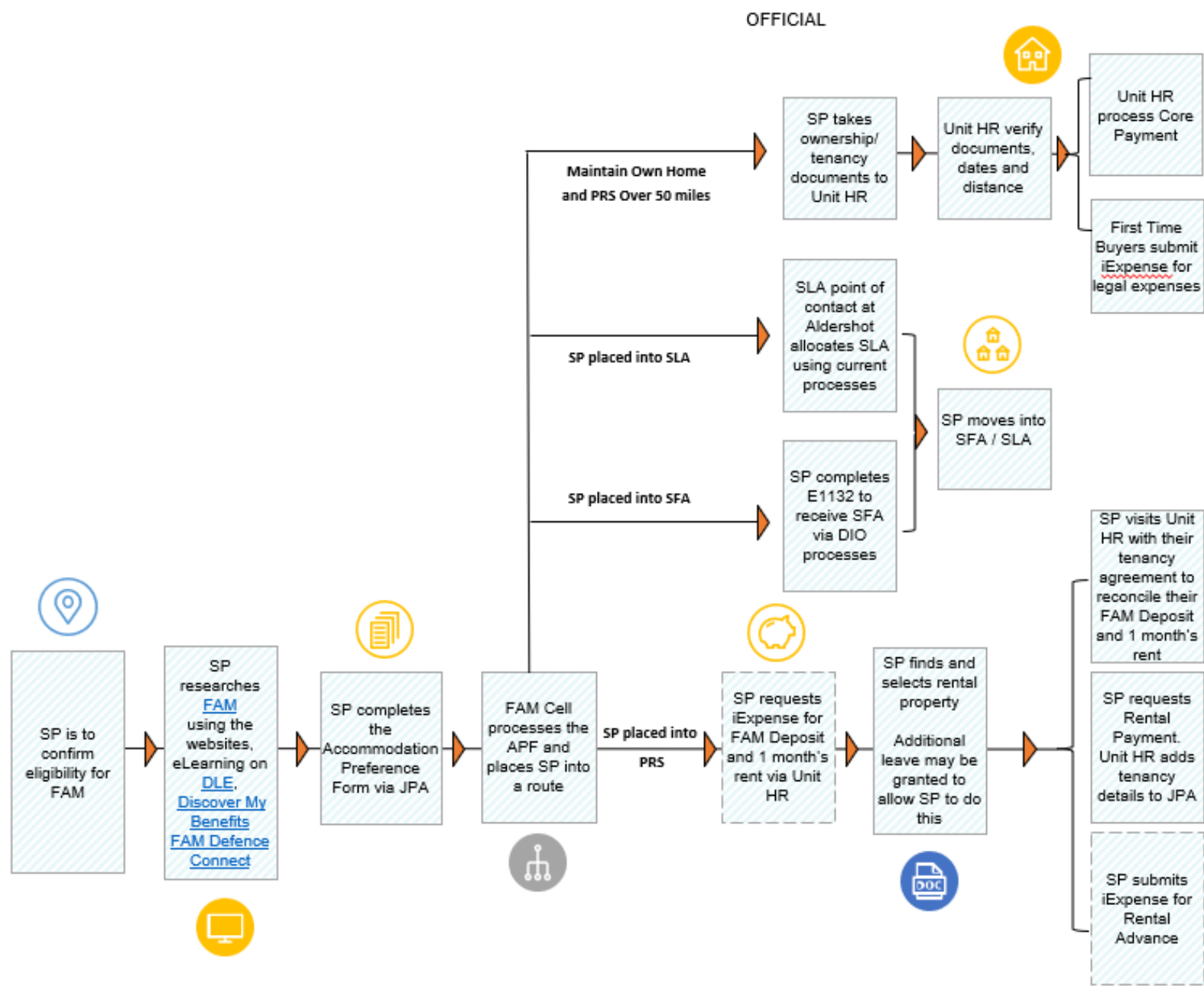
